

## Web Measure of Emotion Bias:

As part of a larger web-based assessment (“Webneuro”) downloaded from Brain Resource, the Web Measure of Emotion Bias is a behavioral assay that utilizes two tasks to measure an individual’s ability to identify facial emotions and emotional bias.

Faces will be shown one at a time.  
Below each face you will see six emotion word buttons.  
CLICK on the emotion word that **BEST MATCHES** the emotion of each face.  
You will then see the next face.  
Click as **QUICKLY** and **ACCURATELY** as possible.  
Click **START** to begin the test.
